### **BUILD YOUR MAMO**

### Choose the panel size

## 2

### Remove velcro cover

according to the size of your baby



panels can only be attached to the waist belt without that cover!



You use the correct panel size if the thighs of your baby are well supported almost over their entire lenght. The lower legs should the able to move freely.


Please note that each panel may be adjusted in width for an enhanced fit (see videos).

Attach the velcro cover as soon as you detach the panel from the waist belt.

The cover prevents the hook tape from being clogged. In particular when you wash the panel you have to first attach the cover again.


## connect panel and waist belt

# connect panel and shoulder straps



Close all the snap buttons between panel and waist belt (start with the colored one as the center button). Close the velcro fastening by turning the waist belt to stick to the panel.

Leave all the buttons closed all the time.



Pass the belt through the panel's oval ring from the back side to the front and close all the buttons. Always close the toggle as well for full safety.

Fold back the cover to hide the fastening elements.

### **BABYWEARING**

## close the waist belt

## Seat your baby



moves down to the hip as your baby grows



A mirrow may help you to find a centered position

Make sure to close the buckle properly ("click" sound).

The snap buttons are on the outer side. The panel hangs down from the upper edge of the waist belt.

It is recommended to carry your baby "close enough to kiss".

That means the waist belt is positioned quite high with a newborn baby and moves down as your baby grows.

Make also sure to wear the waist belt tight enough. It has to stay close to your body when your baby is in the carrier.

Excess webbing can be tucked into the small integrated belt pocket.

Place your baby centered towards your stomach, slightly below the upper edge of the waist belt. Swipe the panel up with one hand while holding your baby securely with the other hand. Get the shoulder straps up on your shoulders one after another.

### Fasten the carrier

While holding your baby with one hand, grab both shoulder straps behind your back with the other hand. Once you securely hold both straps, you can use both hands to cross the shoulder straps behind your back and tighten them properly. Your baby should be held tight enough to still have contact even when you bend forward (secure baby shead as needed when you do that test).

Pass the shoulder straps under your baby`s legs and on top of the waist belt towards the front. Make a double knot right under the panel, on the waist belt.

You may pass excess straps back again and make a second knot, or you may use the snap buttons to click excess straps to the sides to the waist belt.

Use the head rest when needed (see videos for details). Attach the head rest using the snap buttons.

### Care instructions

All materials are tested according to the ÖkoTex Standard 100 (class 1). Still, we suggest washing prior to use to remove finish/dressing of the fabrics.

Please always use the velcro cover when you wash a panel. Detach the panel from the waist belt and attach the magenta-colored velcro band. Contact us in case you lost this protection part.

in general, we recommend gentle cycle at 30 or 40 degrees. Teething pads and other parts your baby is "working on", should be washed on a regular basis, at about60 degrees every now and then for hygienic reasons.

Don't expose your MaMo carrier to the sunlight if possible (in the car, e.g.). The color of the natural fibre may change. Read our blog post for more details: unternehmen.mamamotion.de/en/
